Safeguarding - New safeguarding procedures are being rolled out by the diocese. These include safer recruiting of both paid staff and volunteers and also training for all members of the church and particularly for those who work with children or vulnerable adults. The following online training has recently been launched by the diocese, **C0 is for all the church**, whilst C1 is for those who work directly with children or vulnerable adults. C2 face to face training will soon be available for those who lead children's or vulnerable adults work.
